  - b. HC stepping down as treasurer - need a replacement.
3. Funding requests
  - a. £162 for Year 3 reading area. Agreed.
  - b. £194.40 for Christmas books. Agreed.
  - c. Panto - £1,100 tickets. Agreed.
  - d. Panto - £700 travel. Agreed.
4. Fundraising activities
  - a. Halloween disco - feedback.
    - i. Bit too chaotic this year - lots of children, needs more structure next time. Suggestion to make it calmer with games, dancing competition etc.Or split into different time slots for age groups - but this is hard for families with children in different groups. Or invite a DJ/entertainer.
    - ii. Bring out hot dogs straightaway - children were hungry.
    - iii. Decorations being kept at The Falls
    - iv. We lost £33 this year because we spent more on facepainting than we usually do on glo sticks. The facepaint took a while to dry and was popular. Tattoos could be worth trying next time.
  - b. Christmas fair. Check in on:
    - i. Stalls and layout. 14 stalls - similar to last year. Raffle/entry in foyer, uniform and tombola in committee room, some space for seating near the hatch. Open up at 7:30am, stall holders to arrive from 8:30.
    - ii. Volunteers. Ask again on Facebook for any others, including for people to help set up from 7:30.
