- Minutes will be taken at the meetings either by the Chair, or someone appointed by them
- Minutes of the meetings will be made available to all parents and staff via the school's website and /or newsletter attachment, as will the Headteacher's written response
- Agenda's will be compiled by the Chair, having received suggested items
- > All items for discussion must be presented, and agreed, as an agenda item at least 24 hours before the start of the meeting
