Treasurers Report 2023/2024 for BAWB Federation PTFA (Charity No. 1076703)

Firstly we are all very proud of the hard work and enthusiasm PTFA members put in to raise important funds for the BAWB Federation as well as bringing pleasure and help to the children and the school community. Thank you to you all.

This year we have contributed nearly £4000 to the Federation for the following items:

EYFS Mobilo - £101.71

Food tech equipment for all years - £82.48

Pantomime tickets plus transport for all children - £1655

Christmas books for all children - £210.12

Our total income for the year was £6478.67 and came from a wide range of sources.

Our annual costs were £173 comprising insurance (through Parent Kind) and a Lottery Licence for the raffles.

Cash at bank on 1/09/2023 was £2162.17; at the end of the financial year it was £4506.14

representing a net increase in funds of £2360.63. We are carrying some debt for the year for items agreed by the committee but not yet invoiced by the Federation (c£1150). Paying these additional donations will still leave us with a balance of >£1000.

Beth's excellent organisational skills and Helen's proactive attitude have been instrumental in the success of the PTFA.
