## Partnerships for Inclusion of Neurodiversity in Schools (PINS) Programme

We are writing to invite you to attend the upcoming parent carer support and information session on 'Social, Emotional and Mental Health - SEMH'

**In this session**, we will be exploring social emotional and mental health. What it means, early warning signs to look out for, practical tips to support your child and signposting to services for further support.

The session will be taking place within Bainbridge school on **Tuesday 11th March** at 3.45pm. The session will last approximately 1.5 hours, with an opportunity for Q&A, including talking about individual scenarios. The school has kindly offered to assist with childcare during the session.
